Volunteer Spanish Language Program General Information

The Spanish classes are taught once a week for thirty minutes by volunteer teachers. The program materials, teacher's manual, CD's and teaching video are provided by the elementary school. Training is provided by the district coordinator.

The following skills are needed for the various positions:

<u>Volunteer teachers</u> - An elementary level of Spanish, a proficient accent and the ability to work well with children is required. Volunteers must be able to commit for the school year.

<u>Coordinator</u> - Knowledge of Spanish is NOT necessary. Enthusiasm, good organizational skills and the ability to work well with a variety of people are needed.

<u>Asst. Coordinator(s)</u> - Knowledge of Spanish is NOT necessary. Help coordinator with material inventory and organization as well as putting together curriculum materials for the program.

<u>Substitute volunteer teachers</u> - An elementary level of Spanish and a proficient accent is required. This is for anyone who would like to volunteer to teach, but is unable to commit to teaching every week for the entire school year.
